Dear beloved of Trinity,

This week in our Tell the Story, Be the Story, we will focus on the prophets. They are categorized in 2 sections, the major prophets and the minor prophets. Just because some have the title of “major” does not mean their content is more important or more inspiring than the “minor” prophets. It only means their books are physically longer than the others.

Prophets are those who spoke for God to God’s people. They spoke words of promise, warning, judgement, mercy, grace and of a coming Messiah. You can imagine that some were well received while others ran for their lives, literally. All were faithful (eventually, Jonah) to God even when their assignments were difficult.

We will look at the timeline of the prophets as it stretched over a period of approximately 400 years beginning after King Solomon’s reign and continuing after the Jews were allowed by Cyrus the Great to return to Jerusalem after the exile.

Some of the prophets’ time overlapped, serving as contemporaries.

This week we will look at each prophet and their main message to the Israelites. Can the prophets of old still speak to us?

Do we have modern day prophets? What is the role of a prophet today?

Join me on Sunday, Father’s Day, to learn about the prophets.
