Things to know about this Sunday

- 8:00 Worship

- ◆ we encourage you to use the projection screens to follow the service.
- ◆ There will be no coffee fellowship after 8:00 worship. We encourage 8:00 attendees to exit the building immediately after worship to allow the next service to use the parking spaces.
- ◆ Masks are recommended but not required.
- ◆ The pews are marked off every other one to allow for social distancing. Follow the guidance of the ushers.
- ◆ This service will become our new time for live stream worship.

- 9:30 worship

- ◆ ushers will be directing you to your parking spot. Large vehicles (pick ups and large SUVs will be directed to the back of the parking lot to allow for better visibility for smaller cars)
- ◆ the offering box will be placed on the flatbed. You may come up at any time during the service to put your offering in the box.
- ◆ The service will be broadcast through AM radio transmission. Tune in to 1610 AM to find the worship service. If for some reason you cannot get reception, ask the person next to you to roll their window down and turn up their volume.
- ◆ Feel free to sit next to your car in lawn chairs or sit on the back of your vehicle, tailgate fashion.

We are looking forward to seeing you on Sunday. The Council has spent many hours discussing the safest way to bring back in-person worship to keep everyone safe and healthy. Remember, if you do not feel safe returning, live streaming will always be available. Also, our services are available on Tea Trinity's YouTube channel.
