Dear Beloved of Trinity,

This week we begin a new sermon series entitled, Faces of our Faith. Throughout scripture we hear of many Biblical heroes who rely on God for courage and hope in the face of fear, temptation and despair. These are heroes who we admire and look up to. There are many stories of faith in the Bible that we do not hear about – people who are not as familiar yet still have a powerful story to tell. These are heroes who made a difference but are often overlooked as background characters. This series will take a look at some of these characters and see what they can teach us about our life today.

This Sunday, we ill hear about Queen Vashti, who was married to the arrogant and prideful, King Xerxes. After a long drunken party he throws for the nobels and officials in his kingdom. When he requests his wife, who was very beautiful, to come before all these men in her crown so that they may "gaze upon her", she refused. You may think that that is not so astonishing but back in Queen Vashti's era, this refusal was beyond comprehensible. It was down-right shocking! And not only shocking but defiant towards her husband. Women were not regarded in the best light, more often as a possession. Many theologians also agree that the King meant for her to come out with only her crown on, in other words naked.

We begin to understand Queen Vashti's hesitation and frustration. She was a child of God who had a significant life story. With courage, she stood up for herself.

Deuteronomy 31:6 says, "Be strong and bold; have no fear or dread of them, because it is the LORD your God who goes with you; he will not fail you or forsake you."

God gives you strength, too, for the hard times. How does knowing God goes with you and will not fail you give you the courage to face your fears and despair? This story speaks to the realization that God loves us beyond our wildest imaginations. He is for you.
