Dear friends in Christ,

Some of you know that my wife and I like to garden. Last summer I grew a particular sunflower that had over two dozen blossoms on each plant. The flowers were lovely in the garden and found their way into many cut flower arrangements. Because I didn't plant any sunflowers this spring, I was happily surprised when several sunflower plants emerged from our flowerbed from the seeds that naturally dropped last fall. All summer I've been looking forward to seeing them bloom again. Now begins the good news-bad news story.

Even though I know quite a bit about plants, I was deceived by a counterfeit. While several sunflowers did bloom, one especially large plant that I had assumed would blossom yellow recently revealed itself as a noxious weed. I'm not sure what it is called, but it looked like a sunflower right up until blossoming time. Here is a side-by-side comparison of the two. Hmm. That is one wily plant. By closely resembling my desired outcome, I tended it carefully and even "weeded" around a weed. Bah humbug.





I heard a sermon many years ago that described sin as a counterfeit of the good. Unless we are careful, the quest for security for self and family can end with greed sneakily growing up right next to the good intention. I think one of the reasons Jesus warns us about greed is because he knows the bad sometimes masquerades as good. This Sunday we begin a three-week sermon series based on questions that have come from members of the congregation. One of the requests was to hear a sermon about money and tithing. Since Jesus has a lot to say about guarding our hearts so that our possessions don't begin to possess us, nurturing generosity is one of the ways to keep greed at bay.

This afternoon, I'm going to cut down that ugly weed and harvest some authentically beautiful sunflower blossoms.
