Dear Beloved of Trinity,

I have been blessed to serve on the South Dakota Synod Council. I along with 3 people from every conference, which there are 7, meet to Exercise trusteeship responsibilities on behalf of this synod, recommend program goals and budgets to the regular meetings of the Synod Assembly, carry out the resolutions of the Synod Assembly, oversee the clergy roster and many more tasks. I love the work we do and the people I interact with. Dave Poppens also serves on the Synod Council.

In the fall of 2022, Bishop Constanza and her staff met with every conference to create a Strategic Vision for the Synod by asking 3 questions.

As a Synod Council, we recently reviewed this plan and found the answers haven't changed much, if any. Read through and tell me what you think.

**What gives you joy?** The top answers were: music, multi-generational ministry opportunities, purposeful gatherings, purposeful volunteering and the Gospel.

**What keeps you up at night?** The top answers were: economic hardships, polarization in our society, mental health and fear for the future of the church.

**How do you envision your relationship with the synod staff?** The top answers were: resources, relationships, programs, communication and faith formation.

We as believers are called to live in community together. It's good for us to consistently be forward moving by being aware of our neighbors, extending grace and forgiveness and doing all we do in love.

The gospel reading for this Sunday is all about forgiveness – the extravagant gift that is offered to us and in turn we offer to those who have wronged us. It doesn't mean we condone the action. Forgiveness is a freeing tool we've been given to separate the pain from the memory.

Let us engage in what brings us joy and what keeps us up at night with the foundation of forgiveness and grace.


