Dear beloved of Trinity,

This Sunday is a big day for us Lutherans. We not only recognize the anniversary of the Reformation but it is also a Milestone Celebration of Confirmation.

A little over 500 years ago, a monk named, Martin Luther, posted on the castle church doors (a common place to post announcements) 95 talking points that he wanted to engage in with the religious leaders of his day. These 95 theses were not received well and essentially, Martin Luther, after a trial, was excommunicated from the Roman Catholic Church. This was never his intention as he loved the church. But he also couldn't agree with the church as to what constituted forgiveness. Was it an indulgence, a purchased piece of paper or was it a total gift of grace? He was firm that it was grace alone through faith alone.

He never intended to leave the church, only to reform it and that he did. Many agreed with him and those people became known as "Lutherans". Martin Luther did not like that moniker as he did not want to draw attention to himself but to always give God the glory. But the name stuck and we are still called Lutheran today as a result of the reforming that took place.

I am so proud of our 9th graders who are confirming their baptismal vows this Sunday. They have attended 2 years of Confirmation instruction, studying the Small Catechism and other pertinent topics of faith. They have reflected and written a faith paper stating what it is they believe in. They boldly proclaim that they believe in God the Father, God the Son and God the Holy Spirit. Confirmation is the launching of their faith as an adult in the church. They become voting members and are expected to continue to grow in faith and contribute to the life of the Trinity family. Many of these confirmands are involved in High School youth group.

I ask 2 things of you this week. Pray for our confirmands. When there is a baptism, I always like to pray, "may they grow in faith as they grow in years." Pray that pray for our 9th graders. Also, pray for the church as a whole. Barna Group has studied the intersection of faith and culture for nearly four decades, with an emphasis on generational trends. They have found that only 1 in 4 Americans is a practicing Christian. (https://www.barna.com/research/changing-state-of-the-church) The church across denominations, is in decline. Our prayer this week is that faith is ignited and relationships in Jesus are renewed or created. We are blessed by the growth we experience at Trinity. We are an anomaly. Keep lifting up all ministries and in all things, give thanks.

Thank you, people of God, for your faithful service. Together, we are team Trinity.



- As many people have moved away from carrying cash, you now can make financial gifts during worship or at any time through the Venmo app @teatrinity
- If you are retired and have an IRA, did you know that you can make tax free charitable contributions with the help of your financial advisor?
- If you would like to learn additional skills about being a good steward of all your finances
 including how to tackle paying off debt, the Board of Stewardship will be offering the Dave
 Ramsey Financial Peace University class this winter. There will be ten full scholarships for this

When will I get my photos or printed directory?

- Photo orders placed after Oct. 31 will be shipped to your home address for a fee.
- **Photo Prints:** The photo prints will be delivered to the church mid-November as a bulk shipment unless otherwise noted in your order. Just in time for Christmas
- **Photo Directory:** The photo directory will be delivered to the church beginning of December as a bulk shipment.
- **Digital Photo Download:** You can download the photo immediately after the photographer releases the order.
