Dear friends,

The other day I left my church work for a couple of hours to plant a tree that I bought awhile back and hadn't gotten in the ground yet. Since it is a big tree in a flat bottomed plastic pot I assumed it would stand up on its own for a several days (or to be more accurate, a week or more). I was wrong. Each morning I'd stand it up and sometime during the day the wind would lay it out like it had been tackled by a linebacker. Eventually, I quit picking it up. Having it lying right next to the street didn't make me look like the most thoughtful neighbor either. Then I witnessed a miracle. The tree stood up seemingly on its own two days in a row. I didn't actually see it stand up, but I'd leave for work in the morning with it splayed out and come home to it reaching for the heavens. Hmm.

On Wednesday, I estimated that I had enough time between staff meeting and teaching confirmation to slip into my blue-striped, Key-brand, bib overalls and get those roots in the ground. I had finished digging the big hole right near the street when a stranger stopped his car and asked if I needed a hand. After a street side introduction, he told me that he had seen the tree on the ground a couple of times when he went to pick up his kids from school and had stood it up. Ah ha! The miracle.

I found out that Chris had moved into a house a couple of blocks away after moving from another part of the country. We shared experiences about moving and had a pleasant chat. I thanked him for the offer but told him that I'd be able to take my time and get the tree planted. We both enjoyed the conversation and with a neighborly wave he left.

Psalm 1 compares people delighting in the law of the Lord to trees that yield good fruit. As I thought of the opportunity to meet a new neighbor and open the opportunity for an unexpected friendship, I felt like the tree I was planting had already borne fruit. When I thought I was slipping away from church to plant a tree, God had another idea. That tree planning would bring the church to my neighborhood.

Like the church musician, Jay Beech, reminds us:

"The church is not a building where people go to pray. It's not made out of sticks and stones. It's not made out of clay.

We are the church."




"Bible Crash Course"

Trinity Directory Prints

You took your Directory Photo, now what?

Time to order your prints and/or directory! Photos are typically available to view about 24 hours after your photo has been taken.

Contact the office and you can set up an appointment, call 605-498-2343

When will I get my photos or printed directory?

- Photo orders are due October 31st! Orders placed after Oct. 31 will be shipped to your home address for a fee.
- **Photo Prints:** The photo prints will be delivered to the church mid-November as a bulk shipment unless otherwise noted in your order. Just in time for Christmas
- Photo Directory: The photo directory will be delivered to the church beginning of December as a bulk shipment.
- **Digital Photo Download:** You can download the photo immediately after the photographer releases the order.

What is a Digital Directory?

This is a new option Trinity is offering a digital version of the directory that you can access on your computer, tablet or phone! This will be available mid to late November. Watch your email for more information in the coming weeks.

Having trouble ordering?

- Sunday Mornings: Volunteers will be available on Sunday mornings between services to help order your photos, print directory or just ask questions about pricing. Look for the "Church Directory Photo Signup" table in the Gathering Space.
- By Appointment: Contact the office and you can set up an appointment, call 605-498-2343.
