Dear Beloved of Trinity,

This Sunday we are wrapping up our Stewardship emphasis, Trinity, In It Together. Did you know that there are over 2500 passages in the Bible on how we manage money? It says more about money than it does about prayer. Not to minimize the importance of prayer but from God's perspective, this is a big deal but perhaps not in the way we think that it is a big deal. It's not about the amount of money we have or don't have, it's about our hearts and what we make more important than Him.

When I teach 4th grade Milestone, which is "What Does God Have to Say About Money?", we look to the Bible for answers. The first Biblical principle is from Psalm 24:1, "the earth is the Lord's and everything in it. The world and all its people belong to him." And Psalm 89:11, "the heavens are yours and the earth is yours; everything is the world is yours – you created it all." So, stewardship is the good management of all God has given us, our time, our possessions and our money. We are called to be good stewards. Corinthians 9:7 says, "you must each decide in your heart how much to give. And don't give reluctantly or in response to pressure. For God loves a person who gives cheerfully."

Mark Allen Powell, in his book, Giving to God, says we should not give to a budget but instead give from the heart. The amount we give shouldn't be determined by the church budgetary needs but by "the goodness of God that takes hold of us and transforms us within."

What a good God we serve. A God who provides for our needs and more. It is a privilege to give back to God and to care for our neighbor. The good news is, we are a team in this endeavor. We work together for the greater good. We are Trinity, In It Together.
