
Dear friends in Christ,

This past Sunday I gave a presentation about the time my wife and I spent in Jerusalem and Bethlehem last January. When we gave the first presentation about our Holy Land trip last spring, we showed pictures and videos of Galilee and the Jordan river. At that time, I told the group that I needed more time to think about how to present my rather jarring experience of moving back and forth between the West Bank city of Bethlehem and Jerusalem. Moving through checkpoints and the security walls brought the experience of the Biblical sites into sharp contrast with modern

political tensions.

Like many of you since the war began, I have been following the tragic news of the deaths of Israelis and Palestinians with deep sadness and prayer. I am grateful that I had the experiences last winter to help me think through the challenges facing a place that is sacred to three world religions,

Christianity, Islam, and



Judaism. All three religions share a family tree with roots in Genesis and branches that reach into the modern-day conflicts. If you are available, I hope you can attend.
