Their holy moment came as a shock at first when the angel suddenly appeared and then as a holy calling. "Go see the baby – this thing that has happened." And when they went, they saw and they couldn't help but spread the word. What a beautiful example for us to follow as well.

God calls us to many exciting, adventurous and normal things. He equips us and sends us much like the shepherds. As Christmas approaches, let us remember to give God thanks in all things and to take our role as a shepherd seriously – come see Jesus and go and tell.
